Job Description

Director - Assets Optimization

Two (2) jobs: Oversees and coordinates the activities associated with the scheduling function. Coordinates all scheduling activities within a region and assumes accountability for bottom line profit and loss. Reports to the vice president - commercial.

Director – Development

One (1) job: Leads the development and/or acquisition of new pipelines and storage assets. Manages third party consultants to approved budget and schedule with direct responsibility for coordination of all commercial-related activities from the inception of project development and continuing through project operations. Reports to the vice president – commercial.

Director - Operations

One (1) job: Directs and leads the operations of Pipelines and Storage facilities in the US. This position plays a central role in establishing strategic objectives and developing operating plans for Pipelines and Storage operations. This a highly specialized position which has the responsibility for serving the Pipelines and Storage Operations as a lead professional regarding management, safety and environment, reliability, availability, efficiency, operating flexibility, corporate legal compliance and cost control. Maximizes profitability by achieving key objectives. Reports to the vice president - operations.

Commercial Development Manager

Two (2) jobs, (one vacant): Responsible for analyzing markets, developing pricing and marketing approach, negotiating and closing customer service agreements for pipelines and storage assets – both development phase and operating. Support / manage project development activities through market analysis, running open seasons, and negotiating precedent agreements with customers. Manage regulatory issues including tariff development and modifications, certificate compliance and other regulatory initiatives. Provide cross-functional management and contract negotiation support to technical development and finance teams as required. Manage & support acquisitions activities. Reports to vice president – commercial.

Gas Control/Measurement Supervisor

One (1) job: Responsible for managing the gas control function for domestic and Mexican pipelines operations. Designs and implements overall gas control structure and organization to meet the business unit's growing demands and project expansion. Participates in the evaluation of energy saving opportunities, provides technical and financial analysis for implementing measurement and verification plans for projects under development. Reports to the director - operations.

Senior Gas Controller

One (1) job: Monitors and regulates flow of natural gas throughout distribution system to ensure volume and pressure of gas required for consumers' demands. Adjusts controls to regulate gas flow and pressure through system. Reports to the gas control/measurement supervisor.

Gas Controller

Four (4) jobs: Responsible to monitor and regulate flow of natural gas throughout distribution system to ensure volume and pressure of gas required for consumers' and shippers' demands. Reports to the gas control/measurement supervisor.

Natural Gas Representative

One (1) job: Assists in managing intra-month marketing book, optimizing company owned assets, balancing supplies to markets, and mitigating price risk through daily incremental purchases and sales, transportation, storage, pipeline parking and lending services and financial derivative instruments as needed. Reports to the vice president – commercial.

Volume Analyst

Two (2) jobs: Nominates schedules and monitors gas transportation on pipelines systems in compliance with contract provisions and the pipeline's tariff, timing and procedures, purchases, sales and storage on pipeline systems in order to minimize transport cost. Reports to the vice president - commercial.
