

NOTICE OF TARIFF FILING FOR SABINE PIPE LINE LLC

On February 26, 2026, Sabine Pipe Line LLC (“Sabine”) filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“FERC”) in Docket No. RP26-526-000 a limited waiver request of Section 7.27.3 of the General Terms and Conditions (“GT&C”) of its FERC Gas Tariff, Second Revised Volume No. 1 (“Tariff”) to permit a ninety (90) day extension of time to complete the annual redetermination of and to submit Sabine’s annual Fuel Gas Percentages (“FRPs”) and Unaccounted For Gas Reimbursement Percentage (“UFRP”).

Pursuant to Rules 207 and 212 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission") Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. §§ 385.207 and 385.212 (2025), Sabine Pipe Line LLC ("Sabine") herein requests a limited waiver of Section 7.27.3 of the General Terms and Conditions ("GT&C") of its FERC Gas Tariff, Second Revised Volume No. 1 ("Tariff") to permit a ninety (90) day extension of time to complete the annual redetermination of and to submit Sabine's annual Fuel Gas Percentages ("FRPs") and Unaccounted For Gas Reimbursement Percentage ("UFRP"). Good cause exists to grant this request for the reasons set forth below.

BACKGROUND

GT&C Section 7.27.3 requires Sabine to make an annual filing which updates Tariff Section 5 Statement of Transportation Rates for the adjusted FRPs and UFRP. The annual filing is to be made on or before the last day of February of each year, with such adjustments to become effective as of April 1 of the same calendar year. Although Sabine has been working diligently to meet this deadline for the current year and has completed an initial calculation of updated fuel retainage percentages, it has been determined that certain fuel and lost and unaccounted for data requires further verification and analysis. Sabine needs additional time to complete in-progress meter testing to investigate and to determine whether and to what extent certain lost and unaccounted for volumes may be attributable to meter error.

WAIVER REQUEST

Sabine requests waiver of GT&C Section 7.27.3 to permit a 90-day extension of time until

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May 29, 2026, to submit its annual filing of its fuel and line loss reimbursement percentages.¹ To ensure that shippers are not unduly burdened or prejudiced by the extension, Sabine intends to retain the currently-effective FRPs and UFRP through the end of June 2026.² Sabine proposes that the updated FRPs and UFRP that Sabine will file by May 29, 2026, and not take effect until July 1, 2026. Maintaining the current FRPs and UFRP ensures that shippers are not subject to percentages that fail to incorporate the prior period adjustments required to accurately reflect the fuel and lost and unaccounted for data for the 12-month period specified in GT&C Section 7.27.3.

Granting the requested extension of time will serve the public interest and the interest of Sabine's shippers, by permitting Sabine to thoroughly review the data from ongoing meter testing, ensuring the resulting FRPs and UFRP accurately reflect actual system performance. This reduces the risk of over-recovery or under-recovery of FRPs and UFRP from shippers. Granting the requested extension would be consistent with extensions of time granted to other pipelines under similar circumstances.³
