Subject: OFO - Critical Mode Notice

Per [NOAA public advisory](#), Hurricane Laura has strengthened into a major hurricane, with potentially catastrophic storm surge, extreme winds, and flash flooding expected along the northwest Gulf Coast tonight (8/26/2020). Evacuation of on-site personnel may become necessary with little to no notice. As such, Cameron Interstate Pipeline (“Pipeline”) is providing notice of a change in operating conditions, from [Normal] Mode to Critical Mode.

Pursuant to Section 8.9 of the General Terms and Conditions of its FERC Gas Tariff, Pipeline is issuing an Operational Flow Order (OFO) - necessary to preserve system integrity, stabilize operations and maintain reliable services. This OFO is effective Gas Day¹ [08/26/2020] beginning with the [Intraday 1] cycle and will continue until further notice.

Pipeline may interrupt or discontinue service at any time in response to emergency situations. Shippers are directed to reduce upstream receipts to EPSQ.

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¹ All listed dates represent gas days as defined in Cameron Interstate Pipeline’s Tariff to mean a period of twenty-four consecutive hours, beginning and ending at 9:00 a.m. (Central Clock Time).
