



## Non-Critical Notice

To: Eastern Shore Natural Gas (Eastern Shore) Shippers and Customers

Re: Notice of Estimated Interruptible Transportation Capacity Available

Eastern Shore is providing a three-day rolling estimate of the available Interruptible Transportation capacity (secondary Firm Transportation (FT) and Interruptible Transportation (IT)) on its Interactive Web Site (IWS) as a weekday Non-Critical Notice. The following chart reflects the quantity of IT service that is projected to be available at each delivery zone on Eastern Shore's system:

To the extent that the total nominated quantities exceed the available capacity identified in the chart above, Eastern Shore will prorate the nominated quantities based on scheduling priorities, in accordance with Section 21(g) of the General Terms and Conditions in Eastern Shore's FERC Gas Tariff.

This information is intended to provide Shippers and Customers with an easy reference source of information regarding IT availability. Eastern Shore may be required to institute capacity restrictions that could affect the projected IT quantities shown above if operational conditions dictate. As operational conditions change, Eastern Shore will attempt to provide notice of any such changes when services may be limited and a change in the projected available IT quantity occurs.
