

JOB TITLES AND JOB DESCRIPTIONS: TRANSMISSION FUNCTION EMPLOYEES

Transmission Providers are required to post the job titles and job descriptions of their Transmission Function Employees (TFEs), per 18 CFR § 358.7(f). Golden Pass Pipeline LLC (GPPL) identifies the following positions as TFEs.

Job Title	Job Description
Vice-President, Operations	Directs, plans, and controls the operation and maintenance (O&M), as well as the improvement, of the pipeline transmission system. Manages construction and O&M activities and personnel.
Pipeline Operations Supervisor	Responsible for the day-to-day operations of Pipeline and Natural Gas handling facilities to ensure the safe, reliable, and efficient monitoring and control of pipeline systems consistent with business objectives and the governing tariffs providing daily support, planning and direction of the Gas Controllers to provide system stability, reliability, safe operation, and execution of short-term plans. Ascertains problems involved in gas operations; contacts personnel who can supply information and assistance. Analyzes and evaluates data, determines solution, and initiates changes within jurisdiction. Monitors activities, facilities, and databases to ensure company procedures are followed and that compliance is maintained relative to all applicable local, state, and federal regulatory requirements. Supervises Gas Control. Serves as Operations liaison to Commercial group to coordinate movement of gas through the pipeline.
Pipeline Operations Manager	Manages the day-to-day operational activities to ensure the safe, reliable, and efficient monitoring and control of pipeline system and natural gas handling facilities consistent with business objectives and the governing tariffs. Manages annual operations budget, focuses on safety, compliance, reliability, efficiency, and cost management. Supervises Pipeline Operations Supervisor and directs Pipeline Maintenance Supervisor.
Pipeline Maintenance Supervisor	Coordinates and supervises all planned maintenance and repairs on natural gas handling facilities and related equipment. Ensures the safe, reliable, and efficient operation of natural gas transmission and equipment. Coordinates with Gas Control and Gas Scheduling Coordinator if reduced capacities are needed for planned maintenance. Monitors and inspects job sites, facilities, and databases to ensure company procedures are followed and that compliance is maintained relative to all applicable local, state and federal regulatory requirements.
Gas Control Specialist	Responsible for coordination of day-to-day operations respective to maintaining schedule, seasonal load requirements, planned maintenance and any ongoing operating restrictions. Maintains and manages gas control schedule and daily guide. Directs the analysis of historic and projected gas supply and requirements data for modeling, developing and recommending facility and operational plans. Provides Vacation coverage as needed for Gas Controller

Gas Controller	Dispatches, monitors and controls pipeline systems to ensure safe, reliable, and efficient operation consistent with business objectives and the governing tariffs. Ensures continuity of gas service by anticipating, determining, and directing fulfillment of quantity and pressure requirements in a safe, reliable, and efficient manner. Provides direction to the gas schedulers regarding the pipeline's capabilities.
Sr. Director, GPPL Asset Manager	Responsible for the alignment and management of the Asset Leadership Team, as well as the safety, health, environmental, security, integrity, production, reliability, availability, cost management, and management of the profit and loss (P&L) of GPPL. Additionally, manages pipeline tariffs, discounts, and pricing.
Director, Commercial Pipeline Operations	Responsible for capacity marketing and strategic planning activities for the pipeline. Conducts long-term marketing planning studies. Solicits customers for the purchase of existing services, and the development of new services. Identifies and develops pipeline optimization opportunities and is responsible for directing unit staff in the implementation of Golden Pass Pipeline transportation marketing and business development plans and activities. These activities include the identification and evaluation of new business opportunities and the negotiation of service agreements for pipeline expansions, transportation, and construction agreements. Other duties include the supervision of Gas Scheduling Coordinators for natural gas scheduling, nominations, confirmations, capacity release, and general customer service activities. The position is the subject matter expert related to compliance with NAESB Standards and interpretation of FERC gas tariff.
Natural Gas Scheduler	Processes nominations, schedules and confirms natural gas volumes at all pipeline interconnects. Manages operational pipeline imbalances and works with Operations to allocate gas to minimize imbalances. Coordinates with Operations to adjust natural gas deliveries as necessary. Participates in the posting of operational and contract information to the pipeline's website as necessary.
Sr. Natural Gas Scheduler	Responsible for working with GPPL's Commercial team to schedule gas on GPPL's system with a focus on intraday changes and communicating with GPPL's gas control to achieve optimal gas flows on GPPL. Schedules natural gas on GPPL's FERC regulated system with storage and interstate/intrastate pipelines, managing intraday variances including no-notice transportation and firm balancing services.
Director, Commercial Pipeline Optimization	Responsible for recognizing the hourly and daily changing conditions on the GPPL system as well as across the regional market area, communicating proactively with the GPPL Operations and Gas Control team and Firm Transportation Shippers on developments, challenges and opportunities to optimize the GPPL system. Also works with a team of schedulers to timely and accurately manage GPPL nominations and allocations on the pipeline nomination system, including timely postings to the GPPL Electronic Bulletin Boards (EBB) in support of the GPPL Commercial team.
Sr. Commercial Pipeline Analyst	Responsible for providing analytical support to GPPL's Commercial team for optimization of commercial operations in the daily transportation, scheduling and balancing of 2.5 Bcf/d of natural gas moving through GPPL's system. Proactively communicates intraday changes and balancing plans with Gas Control and the Commercial team. Supports GPPL's

	scheduling team as needed from time to time to identify areas of improvement for operational efficiencies. Provides analytical support for the Commercial Pipeline team. Supports Commercial team in developing analysis presentations and reports.
